RESERVATION POLICY

RV/Tent Sites & Primitive Camping

When making a reservation, the reservation SHOULD be paid in full by MasterCard, Visa or Discover.

We cannot GUARANTEE a reservation without a minimum payment equivalent to one night's stay.

If a guest cannot pay in full, the minimum due to guarantee the reservation is the equivalent of one night's stay, leaving the balance due upon arrival.

If a guest doesn't have a credit card, we must receive the paid-in-full amount or the equivalent of one night's stay via mail in the form of a traveler's check, money order or cashier's check within 5 business days of booking the reservation. If not received, the reservation will be cancelled.

370 Lakeside Park is accessible from Cave Springs/Truman Rd. off Highway 370, north of I-70. (Highway 370 is a 12-mile highway that goes from I-70 at St. Peters in St. Charles County to Highway 270 at Hazelwood and Bridgeton in St. Louis County.)

IF YOU'RE HEADING EAST OR WEST ON I-70: Take exit 224 to access Highway 370, and then use the second exit on Highway 370 to reach Truman. Turn left on Truman, and head north to park entrance.

IF YOU'RE COMING FROM THE EAST ON 370: Exit from Highway 370 at Truman, turn right on Truman, and head north to park entrance.

IF YOU LIVE IN ST. PETERS: You can access 370 Lakeside Park by going north on Spencer Road or north on Cave Springs/Truman Rd.
FROM **TRUMAN**: Take Truman north directly to the park entrance. FROM **SPENCER ROAD**: Take Spencer Road north to Salt River Road. Turn right onto Salt River Road to Highway 370, and take Exit 2 on Highway 370 to reach Truman. Turn left on Truman, and head north to park entrance. FROM **MID RIVERS MALL DRIVE**: Take Mid Rivers Mall Drive north to Salt River Road. Turn right onto Salt River Road and head east to Highway 370. Take Exit 2 on Highway 370 to reach Truman. Turn left on Truman, and head north to park entrance. FROM **SALT RIVER ROAD**: Take Salt River Road east to Highway 370. Take Exit 2 on Highway 370 to reach Truman. Turn left on Truman, and head north to park entrance.
